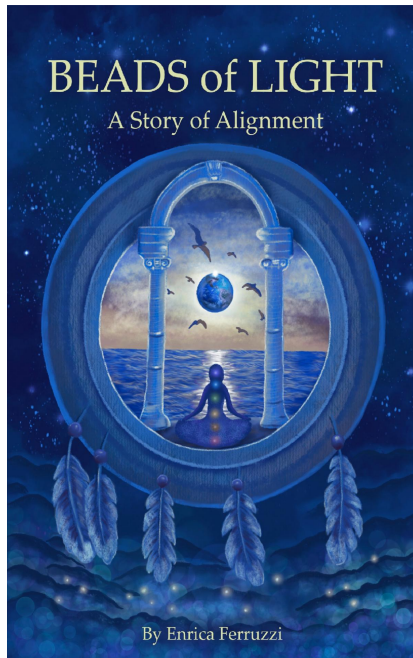

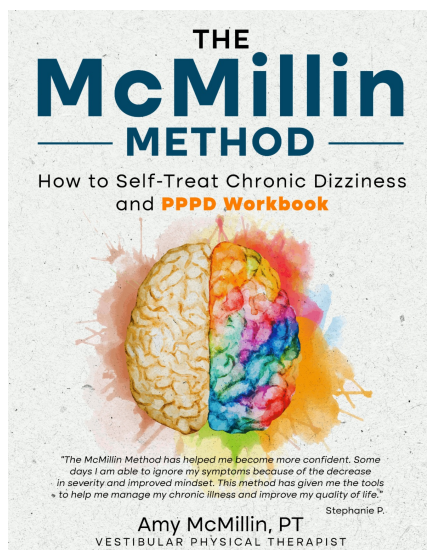

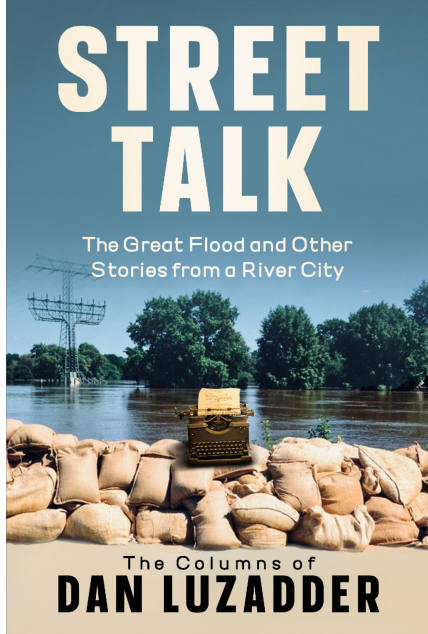

Included are his reflections and reporting on life in the city, including columns he wrote for the newspaper's Pulitzer-winning coverage of *The Great Flood*.

Also in this collection are the author's stories of news events that shaped or influenced life in an historic river town. His accounts range from the shooting there in 1980 of civil rights leader Vernon Jordan, to his chronicle of the miraculous survival of a Fort Wayne man, lost adrift for three days in a lifejacket in the Bermuda Triangle. The author's story of a visit by the tender humanitarian Mother Theresa to this 'city of churches,' is rekindled here, along with tales of everyday people in their everyday lives, snapshots of a time and place.

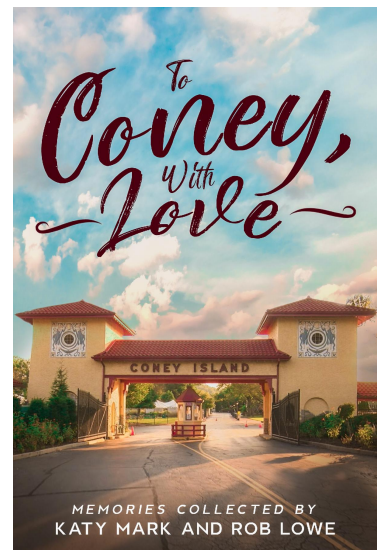
